**Research Goal:**

Trace the paternal Spedl and maternal Schneyda lines of Anna Spedl (ca. 1815-1857), from Úsilov (Slavíkovice), Czech Republic.

Research Plan

The goal for this research session is to research the paternal (Sperl-Spedl) and maternal (Schneyda) lineage of Anna Sperl (Spedl) who was married to Johann (Ján) Tůma and who was the mother of the immigrant ancestor “John” Wenzl Thuma. Anna Sperl, wife of Johann Tůma, died on 12 February 1857 at Úsilov in Slavíkovice parish of what is today the Czech Republic of typhus at the age of 42. She was the mother of 10 children born 1838 to 1855. Her parents were Wenzl Spedl and Anna Schneyda, both from Lipkau.

The priority with this research is to extend the direct line back as far as possible without initially taking the time to research all of the children in each family or tracing the female lines. If an obstacle gets in the way of researching either of these lines, the client would prefer that we not spend a huge amount of time to continue but rather consult with him about other research possibilities.

With that in mind, the initial research steps will include the following plan:

- Find a birth record for Anna Sperl (Spedl), who was born about 1815, likely in Lipkau, daughter of Wenzl Spedl and Anna Schneyda.
- Find a marriage record for her parents prior to her birth.
- Look for her parents’ birth or baptismal records based on their ages listed in their marriage record.
- Continue to repeat this for both parents, then paternal grandparents, and paternal great-grandparents as time permits.

These records will be found in the Catholic church records. The Catholic records for the town of Lipkau (now Libkov) were kept with other towns in the parish of Loučim. These parish records are available for research back to the year 1686.

As research progresses earlier in time, the Czech church records tend to give less and less information. For example, later marriage records provide birthdates, parents names and residences, and grandparents names. As research progresses back into earlier records, the marriage records will generally only give the bride and groom’s names and ages. Even earlier, they only give the names of the bride and groom. If there are several families with the same name in a parish or if a person moved to this parish from somewhere else, it often becomes helpful to look up records of the other children in a family to clarify relationships and to look for important clues that might not be in the records of the direct line ancestor. Because of this, even though the goal is the direct line ancestor, it may be necessary to reach this goal to find records on additional children or death records of direct line ancestors.

Comments:

Although the goal is to just look for direct line ancestors, in cases like this one where we need additional clues, finding later children's birth records since they give more information on the parents' origins or earlier children's birth to narrow down a likely marriage date can aid in extending the family back an earlier generation. Will therefore note information from birth records of Anna Spedl's siblings' births even though will not copy these birth records and thereby save some research time for the goal of extending this family back earlier:

- Anna Spedl, 1: 19 Jun 1811, house 8, father: Wenzl Spedl farmer from here; mother: Anna, daughter of Georg Schweida, farmer from here and Margaretha née Kralin from Navitau, Bistritz Dominions.*

Comments: <i>As birth and death records for Wenzl and Johann Spedl did not show up in indexes where they were expected, it is important to expand this research to include other relatives and other nearby towns for additional clues. Often, people will be "from" a town but may have moved there later than the events we are looking for or lived in additional towns as well. Will follow up on clues from some of the other Spedl families and look up some death records to gain additional clues of birthplace information for Wenzl Spedl, and information on where his parents are recorded in church records from the period 1780s-1820s.</i>

Comments: <i>The client is not interested in research on the siblings of the direct line ancestors at this time, but to find clues to the earlier origins of this family, it is important to look at the records of the siblings since the earlier generation is not coming easily. This will also allow corrections to be made by comparing information in the birth record from 1751 with those before and after, and aid in narrowing down the marriage and death dates of the parents of these children. To save time, copies of these documents were not made but transcripts were done of each birth record, which provided the following information:</i> <i>Of Auszłowa, born 27 Jul, bap. 29 Jul 1745, son Jan.
