**Research Goal:**

Continue tracing the Tuma line by searching parishes near Lautschim, Böhmen, Austria, for their previous place of residence. If the Tuma family reaches a dead end, please try to locate the mother of Katharina Engelmann (c.1771-1835) to complete the 16 great-great grandparents of Michael Cole's grandfather.

Research Plan

John Wenzel Thuma was born 1 December 1848 in Ausilau, Bohemia (now Úsilov, Czech Republic). Prior research established his ancestors back three generations in the old Bohemian records. His earliest known paternal ancestor was Jan Tuma (in Latin records: Joannes Thuma), who was born about 1727 and died 21 May 1781 in Lautschim, Bohemia (now Loučim, Czech Republic). He was listed as having a sister Catharina who died in 1772 at the age of 34 years in Lautschim.

The initial main emphasis of this research will be to extend this family back in time and find the earlier origins and generations of this family as far as possible. Jan Tuma and his wife, Magdalena Nowotna, had at least six children born from 1762 to 1773 in Lautschim. The following research strategies will be employed to achieve your goals:

- Search for the marriage record of Jan Tuma to Magdalena Nowotna in the years 1749-1762 in Lautschim and surrounding Catholic parishes; since their first known child was born in 1762, they likely married during those years
- Look for additional children born to Jan and Magdalena in the period 1749-1762 in this same region
- Search the records of Lautschim for the baptisms of Jan and Catharina Thuma in the period 1725-1740, and for Magdalena Nowotna in the period 1728-1734

If these searches do not identify the prior residence of earlier generations of the Thuma family, the search will be extended to marriage records for the children of Jan and Magdalena and birth records for their grandchildren. It is hoped that finding these records will provide the name of the town where they lived prior to Lautschim. It is often a challenge to discover earlier origins of a family when they moved from an unknown location, however, as peasant farmers in the feudal province of Bohemia, Austrian Empire, they would have been from one of the neighboring towns owned by the same feudal lord, or a nearby town owned by another feudal lord.

Once the earlier origins of this family have been discovered, it may be possible to take the family back another 2-3 generations. The earliest Catholic parish records for Loučim start in 1686, and some neighboring parishes have earlier records. Most records from this period are written in Latin, although sometimes the records can be written in archaic forms of Czech or German. Another difficulty is with surname changes and differences in the way they are spelled. Names were written down by the priest how he thought they were spelled, and similar sounding letters were often interchangeable. We will be on the lookout for spellings such as Thum, Dum, Tuma, etc.

Once the origins of the Thuma family are extended back to the earliest possible ancestor based on the parish records, we can continue tracing your Sperl, Engelman, and Nowotna families, and look for descendants of the siblings of the immigrant John W. Thuma.
