**Research Goal:**

Trace the paternal Tuma and maternal Sprael lines of John W. Tuma (1848-1943), a native of Bohemia, the son of John Tuma and Anna Sprael.

Research Plan

Client information identifies John W. Tuma as born 23 September 1848, probably in Bohemia (Böhmen in German), previously part of the old Austrian Empire and now the Czech Republic, although some sources give Bavaria and suggest his father may have been Bavarian (German). He immigrated about 1871 and settled in Nebraska, according to census records. A possible passenger list for him from 1871, indicated a prior residence at that time as Vienna, the capital of the Austrian Empire. DNA clues suggest he is a likely brother to Joseph Tuma (born April 1845 in Austria/Germany), also of Nebraska. DNA matches also suggest a relationship with Anna, daughter of Anton Tuma (born June 1839) from Ústaleč, Klatovy District, Plzeň (Pilsen) region, Bohemia, and a František “Frank” Tuma who was born 8 October 1864 in Ústaleč. John W. Tuma’s mother was named *Sprael* and the surname *Sperl* also shows up in DNA matches.

With several independent leads suggesting an origin for the Tuma and Sprael families to be in and around Ústaleč, this should be the first place for us to start our research. Plzeň region is on the border with Bavaria, which also adds credence to this being the part of Bohemia where the family was from. The following strategies will be employed in researching this family:

- Search the Ústaleč Roman Catholic church records for the birth records of John W. Tuma, Joseph Tuma, Anton Tuma, František Tuma, and the father of František Tuma, to see the degree that these individuals may or may not be related to each other from those records. Researching these various individuals back to a common ancestor could provide a hypothesis of the connection to these families.
- Search Catholic church records from towns surrounding Ústaleč, especially those towns associated with the surnames Tuma and Sperl.
- Identify other Tuma and Sperl immigrants from this region of what used to be Bohemia.

The following research steps will depend on the results of these initial steps. If the village of birth for John W. Tuma and his brother Joseph is proven, the next step will be to look for other siblings, and to search for the marriage of their parents, and death information. Czech birth records from the later 1800s often give the names of not only the parents, but also grandparents, providing a wealth of information.

If research in Ústaleč and neighboring towns does not provide definitive results, the next research steps would focus on additional leads from U.S. sources and DNA matches. The distribution of these surnames sometimes can provide clues, and passenger lists of others from the towns in Klatovy District that settled in the same area of Nebraska might be considered for additional leads.
